The Bonneville County Fire Protection District No. 1 ("Fire District") held its regular monthly meeting of Commissioners on Tuesday the 11th day of September, 2012, at the offices of Nelson Hall Parry Tucker, P.A., at 490 Memorial Drive, Suite 200, Idaho Falls, Idaho 83402 convening at 12:00 p.m.

The following were present:

Commissioners Dave Long, Dan Gubler and Ralph Isom were present in person. The following were also present: Fire District Liaison, Dick Fowler; Accountant Terri Gazdik; Legal Counsel, Douglas R. Nelson; City of Idaho Falls Fire Chief, Dean Ellis; Bonneville County Zoning Administrator, Steve Serr. Absent from the meeting was Ammon fire Chief Stacey Hyde.

Notice of the time, place and purpose was posted at the Bonneville County Courthouse and at the premises of 490 Memorial Drive, Idaho Falls, Idaho. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes.

It was declared that a Quorum of Commissioners were present and due notice of the meeting had been posted in accordance with law.

DISCUSSION AND ACTIONS

- 1. <u>Call to Order.</u> The meeting was called to order by Dan Gubler, acting as Chairman who confirmed that a quorum of Commissioners was present.
- 2. <u>Approval of Minutes.</u> Minutes of the regular meeting of Commissioners held at 12:00 p.m. on August 14, 2012, were reviewed. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Dave Long and seconded by Ralph Isom, and the same was unanimously approved.
- 3. Approval-Monthly Accountant Report and Bill Authorization. The summary of accounts payable dated September 11, 2012, prepared and submitted by Accountant, Terri Gazdik was reviewed. The bills totaling the sum of \$13,042.14 were reviewed and discussed. A motion was made by Ralph Isom to pay the bills as listed on the summary of accounts payable. This motion was seconded by Dave Long and approved unanimously.
- 4. Report by Dick Fowler. Dick Fowler reported that the old Lincoln fire station has been rented by the new owner and that the owner desires to have the emergency early warning notice sirens on pole be removed. Chief Ellis indicated that the City could move the sirens for fre unless a new pole (approximately \$1,440.00) is required.
 - Mr. Fowler reported that the annual budget hearing was held and that the budget was approved and the L-2 Budget Sheet was timely sent to the County by the District accountant.
- 5. Report by Dean Ellis. Chief Ellis stated that he had no business to report at this meeting.

6. New Business. There was no new business discussed at the meeting.

7. <u>Adjournment</u>. There being no further business to come before the Board of Commissioners at the meeting a motion was made.

The proposal to be discussed is: (1) an application to annex certain real property consisting of approximately 28.16 acres, as described below; (2) a request to amend the City of Ucon Comprehensive Plan to change the designation of that property from Residential to Commercial; and (3) a request to change the zoning classification of that property from its current designation to CM-Commercial & Manufacturing.

GENERAL LOCATION: The properties are located at 9947 and 10019 N Yellowstone Highway.


