# BONNEVILLE COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 1 Minutes of Regular Meeting held March 10, 2020

The Bonneville County Fire Protection District No. 1 ("Fire District") held its regular monthly meeting of Commissioners on Tuesday the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020 at the offices of Nelson Hall Parry Tucker, PLLC, at 490 Memorial Drive, Suite 200, Idaho Falls, Idaho 83402 convening at 12:00 p.m.

# The following were present:

Commissioners Dan Gubler and Ralph Isom were present. Commissioner Dave Long was excused. The following were also present: District Liaison, Dick Fowler; legal counsel, Doug Nelson; District accountant, Terri Gazdik; Bonneville County Planning Supervisor, Steve Serr; and, City Fire Chief, Duane Nelson and, City Deputy Chief of Operations, John Perry.

Notice of the time, place and purpose was posted at the Bonneville County Courthouse and at the premises of 490 Memorial Drive, Idaho Falls, Idaho. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes.

It was declared that a Quorum of Commissioners were present and due notice of the meeting had been posted in accordance with law.

# **DISCUSSION AND ACTIONS**

- 1. <u>Call to Order</u>. The meeting was called to order at 12:21 p.m. by Dan Gubler, acting as Chairman.
- 2. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>. Minutes of the regular meeting of Commissioners held on February, 11 2020 were reviewed, and following a motion made by Ralph Isom and seconded by Dan Gubler the minuets were approved.
- 3. Monthly Financial Report and Bill Authorization. The summary of accounts payable dated March 10, 2020, prepared and submitted by Accountant Terri Gazdik, was reviewed. Following discussion and upon motion made by Ralph Isom and seconded by Dan Gubler the report was approved including a total expenditure of \$5,671.17.
- 4. Review and Discussion. The following items were reported or discussed:
  - a. Fire Chief Duane Nelson reported that House Bill 09 which provides for a freeze on budgetary increases, passed the House.
  - b. It was reported that the Department responded to a total of 121 calls in February. Of these 20 were fire only and no major damage was reported.

- c. Chief Nelson stated that the Fire Department is seeking approval from the City Council to retrofit all stations with the G-2 alerting system.
- d. Brief discussion took place regarding the invitation to bid on the Faust build out project. It was reported that a walk through with contractors would take place on March 24<sup>th</sup> and bids would be opened on April 9<sup>th</sup> and then reviewed by the Commissioners on April 14 at the beginning of the regular meeting.
- e. It was reported that the north side of the Grange building needed repair to some siding. It was also reported that the Hemmett has been finished by Teton Communications and that Grover's will do wiring and incidentals in order to place it into service. The truck equipment has been ordered.
- 6. <u>County Report.</u> Steve Serr reported that the large subdivision proposed south of the Melaleuca building was recommended by the County Commissioners for disapproval.
- 7. <u>Adjournment</u>. There being no further business to come before the Board of Commissioners at the meeting a motion was made to adjourn was made by Dan Gubler and seconded by Ralph Isom and approved at 1:43 p.m.
