# BONNEVILLE COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 1 Minutes of Regular Meeting held August 8, 2017

The Bonneville County Fire Protection District No. 1 ("Fire District") held its regular monthly meeting of Commissioners on Tuesday the 8<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2017, at the offices of Nelson Hall Parry Tucker, PLLC, at 490 Memorial Drive, Suite 200, Idaho Falls, Idaho 83402 convening at 12:00 p.m.

The following were present:

Commissioners Dan Gubler, Ralph Isom and Dave Long were present. The following were also present: Fire District Liaison, Dick Fowler; Legal Counsel, Doug Nelson; and Bonneville County Planning Administrator, Steve Serr. City of Idaho Falls Fire Chief, Dave Hanneman was absent from the meeting.

Notice of the time, place and purpose was posted at the Bonneville County Courthouse and at the premises of 490 Memorial Drive, Idaho Falls, Idaho. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes.

It was declared that a Quorum of Commissioners were present and due notice of the meeting had been posted in accordance with law.

### **DISCUSSION AND ACTIONS**

- 1. <u>Call to Order</u>. The meeting was called to order at 12:16 p.m. by Dan Gubler, acting as Chairman who confirmed that a quorum of Commissioners was present.
- 2. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>. Minutes of the regular meeting of Commissioners held on July 11, 2017, were reviewed. A motion to approve the minutes was made by David Long seconded by Ralph Isom, and the same was approved by unanimous vote.
- 3. <u>Monthly Financial Report and Bill Authorization</u>. The summary of accounts payable dated August 8, 2017, as prepared and submitted by Accountant Terri Gazdik was reviewed. Following discussion and upon motion made by Ralph Isom, seconded by Dave Long and unanimously approved for a total expenditure of \$57,765.02.
- 4. <u>Fire District Budget.</u> A discussion occurred regarding the draft 2017-18 Fire District budget and various revisions to the proposed budget were made. The District accountant agreed to provide Doug Nelson, acting as assistant clerk with the revised draft to be used in publication of the budget in the Post Register in advance of the final budget hearing to be held Tuesday, August 29, 2017 at noon. Thereupon Dave Long made a motion to approve the preliminary budget of \$2,180,696.00 for publication and final hearing which was seconded by Ralph Isom and unanimously approved.

- 5. Report Dick Fowler, District Liaison. Dick Fowler reported regarding the York Fire Station pumps and landscaping drainage. Discussion was also held regarding the storage building being considered for the West Side property.
- 6. <u>County Report.</u> Steve Serr had no report for the meeting.
- 7. <u>Adjournment</u>. There being no further business to come before the Board of Commissioners at the meeting a motion was made to adjourn and approved unanimously at 2:45 p.m.
