BONNEVILLE COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 1 Minutes of Regular Meeting held November 14, 2017

The Bonneville County Fire Protection District No. 1 ("Fire District") held its regular monthly meeting of Commissioners on Tuesday the 14th day of November, 2017, at the offices of Nelson Hall Parry Tucker, PLLC, at 490 Memorial Drive, Suite 200, Idaho Falls, Idaho 83402 convening at 12:00 p.m.

The following were present:

Commissioners Dan Gubler, Ralph Isom and Dave Long were present. The following were also present: Fire District Liaison, Dick Fowler; Legal Counsel, Doug Nelson; District accountant Terri Gazdick; Bonneville County Planning Administrator, Steve Serr; and, City of Idaho Falls Deputy Fire Chief, Dave Coffey.

Notice of the time, place and purpose was posted at the Bonneville County Courthouse and at the premises of 490 Memorial Drive, Idaho Falls, Idaho. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes.

It was declared that a Quorum of Commissioners were present and due notice of the meeting had been posted in accordance with law.

DISCUSSION AND ACTIONS

- 1. <u>Call to Order</u>. The meeting was called to order at 12:15 p.m. by Dan Gubler, acting as Chairman who confirmed that a quorum of Commissioners was present.
- 2. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>. Minutes of the regular meeting of Commissioners held on October 10, 2017, were reviewed, and following motion were unanimously approved.
- 3. Monthly Financial Report and Bill Authorization. The summary of accounts payable dated October 10, 2017, as prepared and submitted by Accountant Terri Gazdik was reviewed. Following discussion and upon motion made by Ralph Isom, seconded by Dave Long and unanimously approved for a total expenditure of \$21,784.00.

4. <u>Discussion and Liaison Report.</u>

It was report by Fire District assistant secretary and election clerk, Doug Nelson, that no persons filed declarations of candidacy to run for election against the commissioners, Daniel Gubler (Subdistrict # 1) or David Long (Subdistrict # 2) and therefore no election was held. A motion was made, seconded and unanimously adopted to recognize the election of Mr. Gubler and Mr. Long to their respective positions to commence for additional terms until the expiration of their new terms in 2021 or until replacements are duly appointed or elected in the event of the departure of either Mr. Gubler or Mr. Long before that date.

Mr. Fowler reported that October had been a "slow" month with few fire call. A discussion occurred regarding the possibility of activating a surplus truck and the hose and equipment needed for that truck.

Mr. Fowler also discussed that the storage building RFP's have been deferred until further discussion has taken place with the architect to review the construction specifications.

Dan Gubler reported that the fork lift had been taken to Arnold Machinery for repairs and that the 2nd Hemmitt is being taken to Grover's All Wheel to finish a few details. The commissioners discussed removing the spare tire from the Hemmitts and replacing that space with other equipment storage.

The group also discussed a holding a holiday party at the Grange building following the first of the year.

5. Report of City Fire Department. Deputy Chief Coffey reported that the Fire Department is reviewing the pre-plan book and is making pre-plan updates which will include facility inspections.

Deputy Chief Coffey also reported on the status of fire hydrant inspection and the challenge to obtain the cooperation of some of the owners of private systems that have declined to assist or permit the checking of the system. Some of the larger system owners complain that the cost of engaging the pumps is extreme.

- 6. <u>County Report.</u> Steve Serr had no report for the meeting.
- 7. Adjournment. There being no further business to come before the Board of Commissioners at the meeting a motion was made to adjourn and approved unanimously at 1: 32 p.m.
