# BONNEVILLE COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 1 Minutes of Regular Meeting held December 8, 2015

The Bonneville County Fire Protection District No. 1 ("Fire District") held its regular monthly meeting of Commissioners on Tuesday the 8<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2015, at the offices of Nelson Hall Parry Tucker, PLLC, at 490 Memorial Drive, Suite 200, Idaho Falls, Idaho 83402 convening at 12:10 p.m.

### The following were present:

Commissioners Dan Gubler, Ralph Isom and Dave Long were present. The following were also present: Fire District Liaison, Dick Fowler; Legal Counsel, Douglas R. Nelson; District Accountant, Terri Gazdik; City of Idaho Falls Deputy Chief David Coffey; Bonneville Planning Administrator, Steve Serr.

Notice of the time, place and purpose was posted at the Bonneville County Courthouse and at the premises of 490 Memorial Drive, Idaho Falls, Idaho. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes. This meeting was re-set to November 17<sup>th</sup> from November 10<sup>th</sup> in order to allow a full quorum of commissioners to be present. Notices were timely posted of such change.

It was declared that a Quorum of Commissioners were present and due notice of the meeting had been posted in accordance with law.

### **DISCUSSION AND ACTIONS**

- 1. <u>Call to Order</u>. The meeting was called to order at 12:10 p.m. by Dan Gubler, acting as Chairman who confirmed that a quorum of Commissioners was present.
- 2. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>. Minutes of the regular meeting of Commissioners held on November 17, 2015 were reviewed. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Ralph Isom, seconded by Dan Gubler, and the same was approved by majority vote.
- 3. Monthly Financial Report and Bill Authorization. The summary of accounts payable dated December 8, 2015 as prepared and submitted by Accountant Terri Gazdik was reviewed. Following discussion and upon motion made by Ralph Isom, seconded by David Long and unanimously approved the report was accepted and authorization for payments totaling \$11,399.86 was approved. A copy of the report is attached to these minutes.
- 4. Oath of Office. It was reported that Ralph Isom had no opposition to his candidacy for Fire District Commissioner of Subdistrict # 3 at the November election. An oath of office was duly administered to Ralph Isom and he affirmed his acceptance of the position and duties for a new 4 year term. The next election for this position is scheduled for November 2019.
- 5. Report by Dick Fowler. Fire District Liaison, Dick Fowler, gave the following reports:
  - A. A discussion regarding the additional build out of the interior of new fire station buildings was held. It was determined that the District should go out to bid on the project so that bids can be evaluated during the month of January, 2016.
  - B. Dan Gubler commented that the light bar kit for truck 482 C had arrived and installation will be scheduled in January, 2016.

- C. A discussion took place regarding the type and components for future additional trucks.
- D. Discussion and approval of the purchase of a blade for the Dodge Pickup for snow removal at the new west and south stations was concluded.
- E. Dick Fowler announced that the annual Fire District holiday gathering is set for 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, February 10, 2016 at the Copper rill restaurant.
- F. Discussion took place regarding follow-up with Housley Pump regarding the CO monitoring system, drain fields at the new facilities, and new hose and rell requirements for the new tanker trusck.
- 6. <u>City of Idaho Falls Report</u>. The City Fire Department Deputy Chief Dave Coffey reported on the following:
  - A. The City Fire Department has acquired add ons to its computer software which will allow posting and tracking of pre-plans as well as fire hydrant locations. This will be added to the dispatch capabilities that are already in place.
  - B. The City is planning for a bid opening for the demolition work on the old Heaton Chiropractic building located on a portion of the site of the new downtown fire station. It is presently intended that the commencement of the demolition will act as the ground breaking event for the new facility.
  - C. It was reported that various grant applications for vehicle exhaust systems are in process.
- 7. County Report. Steve Serr reported on the progress of the new Sheriff's sub-station which is under construction at a location east of the Maverick Store on Lincoln Road. It was also reported that the Bonneville School District is moving forward with plans for the new high school.
- 8. <u>Ammon Report.</u> Chief Hyde announced that Ammon City is working to restructure a residence behind the Ammon City Building into a training and residential center for volunteer fire fighters.
- 7. Adjournment. There being no further business to come before the Board of Commissioners at the meeting a motion was made to adjourn and approved unanimously at 1:18 p.m.
