The following were present:

Commissioners Ralph Isom and Dave Long were present, in person. Commissioner Dan Gubler was excused. The following were also present: Fire District Liaison, Dick Fowler; Legal Counsel, Douglas R. Nelson; City of Idaho Falls Fire Chief, Dean Ellis; County Planning Administrator Steve Serr; and District Accountant, Terri Gazdick.

This truck is not included in the City insured inventory and must be insured separately. Mr Fowler also reviewed a computer drawing of a proposed new steel building received from Steel Vision.
- 5. Report by Dean Ellis. Chief Ellis reported that the lights are in at Station # 2. The Commissioners and Chief Ellis reviewed the timetable and requirements for negotiation/approval of a extension to the current City contract.

- 6. Report by Steve Serr. Steve Serr had no new report from the County.
