Hughes Fire Equipment, Inc. and Pierce Manufacturing, Inc. are pleased to offer for your consideration the enclosed proposal for one (1) 1250 GPM Type 1 Engine, per your Bid specifications & Information.

The price for one (1) International Pumper KB831 is **\$671,014.00**, F.O.B. Customer's facility, Ammon, Idaho. The unit would be ready for delivery within 840 to 1007 calendar days after execution of the contract*. Final payment is due 30 days after the unit leaves the factory for delivery. Pricing is valid until July 25th, 2023.

**Please note: Based on the specification and Pierce's delivery schedule at time of bid, the estimated time for manufacturing is 840 to 976 calendar days. After manufacturing the unit will be delivered to a Hughes Fire Equipment Service Facility where it will receive a pre-delivery inspection prior to transportation to the District. The estimated time for delivery from factory to a Hughes Fire Equipment Service Facility, pre-delivery inspection, and transportation to the District is 30 days. Total time from order placement to receipt of apparatus at your facility would be between 840 to 1007 days.*

Terms:

Payment upon Completion of the Unit at the Factory – If elected, final payment will be due prior to the unit leaving the factory for delivery.

100% Pre-Payment Discount – If elected, payment for the entire contract amount will be due within thirty (30) days of contract execution. If this option is elected, final payment for any changes processed during manufacturing will be due prior to the unit leaving the factory for delivery. If the Fire Department would like to consider a pre-payment of less than 100% the available deduction will be provided upon request.

Transportation - The above pricing includes funds to transport the apparatuses under its own power from the factory to the customer location. If District elects to drive the apparatus from the factory, \$7,000.00 per unit may be deducted from the purchase price. If this option is elected payment in full and proof of insurance must be provided prior to leaving the factory and the customer is responsible for compliance with all state, local and federal DOT requirements including the driver possessing a valid CDL license.

Performance Bond – A performance bond is included in the above price and will be provided after order placement. If customer elects to remove the performance bond \$1,640.00 may be deducted from the



purchase price. All purchase orders must include the following verbiage if a performance bond is elected, "Due to global supply chain constraints, any delivery date contained herein is a good faith estimate as of the date of this order/contract, and merely an approximation based on current information. Delivery updates will be made available, and a final firm delivery date will be provided as soon as possible."

Inspection Trips – Two (2) factory inspection trips for one (1) fire department customer representative are included in the above pricing. The inspection trips will be scheduled at times mutually agreed upon between the manufacturer's representative and the customer. Airfare, lodging and meals while at the factory are included. In the event the fire department is unable to travel to the factory or the factory is unable to accept customers due to the restrictions caused by a national disaster or pandemic then the Dealership reserves the right to use forms of electronic media to accomplish the intention of the inspection trips. Every effort will be made to make the digital media as thorough as possible to satisfy the expectations of the of the fire department. If the Department elects to forgo an inspection trip \$2,400.00 per traveler (per trip) will be deducted from the final invoice.

Future Changes – Various state or federal regulatory agencies (e.g. NFPA, DOT, EPA) may require changes to the Specifications and in any such event any resulting cost increases incurred to comply will be added to the Purchase Price to be paid by the Customer and documented on a Change Order.

Commercial Chassis Price Volatility – Company shall not be responsible for any commercial chassis price increases enacted by a commercial chassis supplier after the execution of contract or purchase order. Any commercial chassis price increases will be passed through to end user and will be documented on a Change Order.

Credit Card Purchases – Payment made for apparatus using a credit card will be applicable to a credit card convenience fee.

Federally Funded Purchases – Company is registered with SAM.gov, is in good standing for purchases utilizing federal funds, and has no past, pending, or threatened litigation that would impact its ability to fulfill the obligations committed herein.


