The Bonneville County Fire Protection District No. 1 ("Fire District") held its regular monthly meeting of Commissioners on Tuesday the 14th day of Septmber, 2021 at the offices of Nelson Hall Parry Tucker, PLLC, at 490 Memorial Drive, Suite 200, Idaho Falls, Idaho 83402 convening at 12:00 p.m.

The following were present:

Commissioners Dave Long, Dan Gubler and Ralph Isom were present. The following were also present: District Operation Officer Dick Fowler; District's accountant Terri Gazdik; District's attorney Doug Nelson; Ammon Area Deputy Fire Chief Steve Berg, Bonneville County Planning Officer, Steve Serr; Ammon Area Consultants, Dana Kirkham and Russell Slack and Patron Derik Nielsen. Also present by telephone connection was Idaho Falls Fire Chief, Duane Nelson.

Notice of the time, place and purpose was posted at the Bonneville County Courthouse and at the premises of 490 Memorial Drive, Idaho Falls, Idaho. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes.

It was declared that a Quorum of Commissioners were present and due notice of the meeting had been posted in accordance with law.

DISCUSSION AND ACTIONS

- 1. <u>Call to Order</u>. The meeting was called to order at 12:08 p.m. by Dan Gubler, acting as Chairman.
- 2. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>. Minutes of the regular meeting of Commissioners held on August 10, 2021 were reviewed, and following a motion made by Dave Long and seconded by Dan Gubler, the same were unanimously approved.
- 3. Monthly Financial Report and Bill Authorization. The summary of accounts payable dated September 14, 2021, prepared and submitted by Accountant Terri Gazdik, was reviewed. Following discussion and upon motion made by David Long and seconded by Ralph Isom, and unanimously accepted, the report was approved including a total expenditure of \$36,000.00.
- 4. Review, Discussion and Action. The following items were reviewed, discussed or actions were taken:
 - a. Dick Fowler and Terri Gazdik reported that the annual budget had been approved and the County has confirmed that the total tax levy for the upcoming fiscal year will be \$3,488,995.00.
 - b. Dick Fowler reported that the projected date of delivery for the new Toyne fire truck has been delayed until February, 2022.
 - c. Mr. Fowler submitted the bids received by the District for various items of surplus property and the commissioners acted unanimously to approve the highest bids and directed Mr. Fowler to conclude the delivery and transfer of property.

- d. Chief Duane Nelson reported 32 fire calls and 2 losses of vehicles as the result of fire during the preceding month. Chief Nelson led a discussion regarding the procedure to respond to fire which are outside of the District boundary and possible billing for those services.
- d. Ammon Area Deputy Chief, Steve Berg, reported that last month Ammon responded to 25 emergency calls and 4 vehicle accidents. No fire losses were reported.
- e. Steve Serr reported that the County is proceeding with plan review for the proposed R C Willy furniture and appliance store to be located south of Sunnyside Road and near the current freeway exit. He also reported and a proposed new Perterbilt truck facility.
- 5. Public Comment. Public comment was invited but none was provided.
- 6. <u>Adjournment</u>. There being no further business to come before the Board of Commissioners at the meeting a motion was made to adjourn by David Long and seconded by Ralph Isom with unanimous approval at 12:59 p.m.
