BONNEVILLE COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 1 Minutes of Regular Meeting held March 12, 2019

The Bonneville County Fire Protection District No. 1 ("Fire District") held its regular monthly meeting of Commissioners on Tuesday the 12th day of February, 2019, at the offices of Nelson Hall Parry Tucker, PLLC, at 490 Memorial Drive, Suite 200, Idaho Falls, Idaho 83402 convening at 12:00 p.m.

The following were present:

Commissioners Dan Gubler and Dave Long were present. Commissioner Ralph Isom was excused. The following were also present: District Liason, Dick Fowler; legal counsel, Doug Nelson; District accountant Terri Gazdick; Bonneville County Planning Supervisor, Steve Serr; City of Idaho Falls Fire Chief, Dave Hanneman; Deputy Chief, Dave Coffee; and, City Council Member, Jim Francis.

Notice of the time, place and purpose was posted at the Bonneville County Courthouse and at the premises of 490 Memorial Drive, Idaho Falls, Idaho. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes.

It was declared that a Quorum of Commissioners were present and due notice of the meeting had been posted in accordance with law.

DISCUSSION AND ACTIONS

- 1. <u>Call to Order</u>. The meeting was called to order at 12:08 p.m. by Dan Gubler, acting as Chairman.
- 2. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>. Minutes of the regular meeting of Commissioners held on February 12, 2019 were reviewed, and following a motion made by Dave Long and seconded by Dan Gubler, were unanimously approved.
- 3. Monthly Financial Report and Bill Authorization. The summary of accounts payable dated March 11, 2019, prepared and submitted by Accountant Terri Gazdik was reviewed. Following discussion and upon motion made by Dave Long, seconded by Dan Gubler the report was unanimously approved for a total expenditure of \$19,396.72.
- 4. <u>Discussion</u>. Fire District Liaison, Dick Fowler, reported on snow damage that has occurred at the Grange building and the need to paint the exterior of the building in various areas was discussed. Mr. Fowler was requested to obtain bids. It was noted that the Fire District budget contains fund allocations for asphalt work to be concluded at the York station along with some concrete curging. Mr. Fowler reported that he is working to obtain bids for this work.

It was reported that the Fire District has received a bill for exterior lights on the westside building for approximately \$1,200.00 from Dale Garner Electrict which Mr. Gubler said he would take to the accountant for payment.

Dave Long made a motion to declare as surplus 12 SCBA units and to donate those units to the City of Idaho Falls. After discussion a motion to that affect was made and passed unanimously. The City intends to declare a similar number of such units as surplus which are also being replaced. The City stated that it intends to donate this equipment to the Roberts Fire District.

It was reported that the new 2019 Ford F-450 truck has arrived and will exchange the box from another truck before putting it into service. Grover's All Wheel submitted the smallest bid to exchange bed and paint \$3,468.50. A motion was made by Dave Long to accept Grover's bid which was seconded by Dan Gubler and unanimously passed. It was mentioned that the F450 wheel covers need to be replaced.

5. Report of City Fire Department. City of Idaho Falls representatives reported on the following:

It was reported that the funds from out of area fire services have recently arrived and the City expect to make payment to the Fire District for its portion in April.

Chief Hanneman announced that he is planning to retire and that the City is in the process of selecting a new fire chief. He mentioned that if the Fire District supports Duane Nelson for that positions then a letter of support might be appropriately directed to Mayor Rebecca Casper.

- 6. **County Report.** Steve Serr had no additional information to report.
- 7. Adjournment. There being no further business to come before the Board of Commissioners at the meeting a motion was made to adjourn and approved unanimously at 2:12 p.m.
