BONNEVILLE COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 1 Minutes of Regular Meeting held August 12, 20014

The Bonneville County Fire Protection District No. 1 ("Fire District") held its regular monthly meeting of Commissioners on Tuesday the 12th day of August, 2014, at the offices of Nelson Hall Parry Tucker, PLLC, at 490 Memorial Drive, Suite 200, Idaho Falls, Idaho 83402 convening at 12:05 p.m.

The following were present:

Commissioners Dan Gubler and Dave Long were present, in person. Commissioner Ralph Isom was excused. The following were also present: Fire District Liaison, Dick Fowler; Legal Counsel, Douglas R. Nelson; District accountant Terri Gazdick; Acting City of Idaho Falls Fire Chief, Duane Nelson; and Steve Serr, County Planning Administrator.

Notice of the time, place and purpose was posted at the Bonneville County Courthouse and at the premises of 490 Memorial Drive, Idaho Falls, Idaho. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes.

It was declared that a Quorum of Commissioners were present and due notice of the meeting had been posted in accordance with law.

DISCUSSION AND ACTIONS

- 1. <u>Call to Order.</u> The meeting was called to order at 12:05p.m. by Dan Gubler, acting as Chairman who confirmed that a quorum of Commissioners was present.
- Approval of Minutes. Minutes of the regular meeting of Commissioners held on July 8, 2014 were reviewed. A motion to approve all minutes was made by Dan Gubler Long, seconded by Dave Long and the same were unanimously approved.
- 4. Monthly Financial Report and Bill Authorization. The summary of accounts payable dated August 12, 2014, prepared and submitted by Accountant Terri Gazdik was reviewed. Upon motion made, seconded and unanimously passed the report was accepted and authorization payments totaling \$270,966.11. A copy of the report is attached to these minutes. An action to move the sum of \$2,967.52 from Key Bank to Scenic Falls Credit Union to bring the balance high enough to avoid monthly fees was also unanimously taken. The commissioner also reviewed the proposed budget for 2014-2015 and directed that the same be published along with a notice of the annual budget hearing.
- 5. Report by Dick Fowler. Dick Fowler reported on status of the new facilities. The group discussed edits to the joint services agreement with the City of Idaho Falls and discussed a goal to have the final agreement ready for District approval at its upcoming special meeting scheduled for August 26, 2014.
- 6. Report by Duane Nelson. Acting Idaho Falls Chief Duane Nelson reported the the Fire Department has been working on procedures to reduce overtime and find additional cost savings. They are hoping to be able to propose a \$58,000.00 reduction in the fire services budget. It was also reported that various locations are being reviewed for a new

down-town fire station. Chief Nelson also suggested that a discussion take place regarding the possibility of adding firefighter housing on the district's 65th South property.

Chief Nelson reviewed the recent Black Hawk area fire. He also committed to provide the District with a list of individual firefighter presently employed by the City.

- 7. Report by Steve Serr. Steve Serr reported the a final walkthrough at the new Melaleuca facility is being scheduled with the goal of obtaining at least a partial occupancy by the end of September, 2014. He also reported that other commercial facilities are being considered in the County within the next year.
- 8. Adjournment. There being no further business to come before the Board of Commissioners at the meeting a motion was made to adjourn and approved unanimously.
