The Bonneville County Fire Protection District No. 1 ("Fire District") held its regular monthly meeting of Commissioners on Tuesday the 9th day of January, 2018, at the offices of Nelson Hall Parry Tucker, PLLC, at 490 Memorial Drive, Suite 200, Idaho Falls, Idaho 83402 convening at 12:00 p.m.

The following were present:

Commissioners Dan Gubler, Ralph Isom and Dave Long were present. The following were also present: Fire District Liaison, Dick Fowler; Legal Counsel, Doug Nelson; District accountant Terri Gazdick; and, City of Idaho Falls Deputy Fire Chief, Dave Coffey; and, Bonneville county Planning Supervisor, Steve Serr.

Notice of the time, place and purpose was posted at the Bonneville County Courthouse and at the premises of 490 Memorial Drive, Idaho Falls, Idaho. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes.

It was declared that a Quorum of Commissioners were present and due notice of the meeting had been posted in accordance with law.

DISCUSSION AND ACTIONS

- 1. <u>Call to Order</u>. The meeting was called to order at 12:15 p.m. by Ralph Isom, acting as Chairman in the temporary absence of Dan Gubler who was delayed. Mr. Isom confirmed that a quorum of Commissioners was present.

It was report by Fire District Liaison that the Hemtt brush truct (tactical tanker) is in the process of having the electrical work completed.

It was reported that the preceding month had be relatively "quiet" in regard to fire calls.

It was reported that inspections of each of the District stations for winterization and snow removal had been completed.

It was reported that the annual holiday party of the District will be held on Monday, February 12th at the Copper Rill restaurant.

Discussion was held regarding the need to obtain additional specification and design assistance for the proposed new storage building in order to proceed to obtain requests for proposals from qualified area contractors. Following the discussion it was unanimously agreed to employ Shed Systems to prepare a design and specifications for the proposed new building.

- 5. Report of City Fire Department. Deputy Chief Coffey stated that the 'City had no report for this month and that matters of the Fire Department are progressing well.
- 6. <u>County Report.</u> Steve Serr was not in attendance at the meeting.
- 7. <u>Adjournment</u>. There being no further business to come before the Board of Commissioners at the meeting a motion was made to adjourn and approved unanimously at 1: 18 p.m.
