BONNEVILLE COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 1 Minutes of Regular Meeting held February 9, 2021

The Bonneville County Fire Protection District No. 1 ("Fire District") held its regular monthly meeting of Commissioners on Tuesday the 9th day of February, 2021 at the offices of Nelson Hall Parry Tucker, PLLC, at 490 Memorial Drive, Suite 200, Idaho Falls, Idaho 83402 convening at 12:07 p.m.

The following were present:

Commissioners Dan Gubler and Ralph Isom were present, in person. Commissioner David Long was present by telephone. The following were also present: District Operations Officer, Dick Fowler (by telephone); attorney Doug Nelson and Ammon Area Consultant, Russell Slack and Ammon Area Fire Chief Stacy Hyde and Deputy Chief Steven Bird, in person. Additional persons present via telephone were: District accountant Terri Gazdik; and City of Idaho Falls Fire Chief, Duane Nelson.

Notice of the time, place and purpose was posted at the Bonneville County Courthouse and at the premises of 490 Memorial Drive, Idaho Falls, Idaho. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes.

It was declared that a Quorum of Commissioners were present and due notice of the meeting had been posted in accordance with law.

DISCUSSION AND ACTIONS

- 1. <u>Call to Order</u>. The meeting was called to order at 12:07 p.m. by Dan Gubler, acting as Chairman.
- 2. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>. Minutes of the regular meeting of Commissioners held on January 12, 2021 were reviewed, and following a motion made by Ralph Isom and seconded by Dan Gubler said minutes were unanimously approved.
- 3. Monthly Financial Report and Bill Authorization. The summary of accounts payable dated February 9, 2021, prepared and submitted by Accountant Terri Gazdik, was reviewed. Following discussion and upon motion made by Ralph Isom and seconded by David Long, and unanimously accepted, the report was approved including a total expenditure of \$38,528.92.
- 4. Review and Discussion. The following items were reported or discussed:
 - a. Dick Fowler suggested that the Fire District obtain titles for the fire trucks held at the City of Ammon. Stacy Hyde stated that Kristina Buchan, City Clerk, should have access to those titles. A discussion regarding bills and expenses associated with the vehicles took place as well as a discussion regarding inspections of equipment and the desirability of having a detailed annual inspection report.
 - b. It was reported that a list of small miscellaneous items and 5 storage lockers were considered surplus property and that the Razor 4 wheel all terrain vehicle should also be considered as surplus property to be sold. Following a discussion and upon motion made by Ralph Isom the

commissioners unanimously adopted a resolution declaring the 5 storage lockers and miscellaneous small items are surplus and no longer needed by the District and that the same shall be sold or otherwise disposed of in accordance with statutory requirements. A decision regarding the Razor all terrain 4 wheel vehicle. It was reported by Dan Gubler that he was successful in obtaining from a government surplus supply a free M870 heavy equipment trailer. The only cost to the District is \$3,100 for shipping and transport of the trailer.

- c. A presentation was made by Steven Bird regarding a possible Fire District web page. The commissioners gave suggestions regarding design and possible content. It was discussed that a final web page design and content be set for future review and discussion.
- d. Chief Duane Nelson stated he had no additional information to report at this meeting.
- e. Chief Stacy Hyde reported regarding 4 false alarm fires and one call involving smoke but no fire and one vehicle fire. He reported that last month was the lowest call level in recent history.
- 5. Public Comment. Public comment was invited but none was provided.
- 6. Adjournment. There being no further business to come before the Board of Commissioners at the meeting a motion was made to adjourn by David Long and seconded by Ralph Isom with unanimous approval at 1:08 p.m.
